in Forssa in 2026**



## Are you interested in culture?

Culture belongs to everyone! Everyone has the right to enjoy concerts, festivals, museums, and theatre even in a tight financial situation. Kaikukortti has been developed as a solution to this problem.

## What is Kaikukortti?

The Kaikukortti card can be used to get free tickets to, for example, festivals, concerts, dance performances or the theatre or to pay for adult education centre courses. Kaikukortti is non-transferrable and free of charge. Kaikukortti is valid for one year at a time.

In addition to Forssa's Kaikukortti offering, you can also use Kaikukortti to get tickets to cultural events organised by other localities. The Kaikukortti network in Forssa is a part of the Kaikukortti network in Tavastia Proper alongside Hausjärvi, Humppila, Hämeenlinna, Jokioinen, Loppi, Riihimäki, Tammela, Ypäjä and The Wellbeing Services County of Kanta Häme (Oma Häme).

## Who is eligible for Kaikukortti in Forssa?


You are eligible for Kaikukortti, if:

- you live in a municipality that is a part of the Kaikukortti network,
- you are a **client** of a social welfare, healthcare and wellbeing actor\* that is a member of the Kaikukortti network in Forssa,
- you cannot afford entrance tickets or courses due to financial constraints, and
- you are 16 years or older.

\*Kaikukortti distributors vary by region. Kaikukortti cards are distributed by some social and health services and well-being and health promotion services in wellbeing services counties and municipalities, as well as in the third sector (parishes and organizations). Examples of distributors include adult social work, outreach youth work, and diaconal work.

## Where to get Kaikukortti in Forssa?

Kaikukortti is distributed by the social welfare, healthcare and wellbeing actors operating in Forssa listed in this brochure.

- Ask the staff for your Kaikukortti card.
  - You don't have to present proof of your income to obtain the card.

### **Renewing your Kaikukortti**

If your Kaikukortti has expired, you can only renew it at the distributor that issued it. Contact the distributor where you received your Kaikukortti. If your customer service is still valid and your financial situation is tight, you can renew the card. Your Kaikukortti is valid for one year at a time.

### **Lost or damaged Kaikukortti**

If your Kaikukortti is lost or damaged, you can get a new card. Contact the distributor where you received your Kaikukortti.

### **Mobile Kaikukortti is now available!**

#### **If you want to use a mobile Kaikukortti, do this:**

If you already have a cardboard Kaikukortti and would like to replace it or add a mobile card, contact the issuer of your Kaikukortti. Anyone can download the Kaikukortti application to their smartphone, but without the help of a card issuer in the Kaikukortti network, the mobile card will not work. **The issuer of the card will give you access to the Mobile Kaikukortti.**

Download the Kaikukortti application from the Google Play or Apple Store. The application is free of charge.

You log in to the application via your personal email.

When you activate your mobile card, you will also automatically have OmaKaiku at your disposal.

#### **What if the mobile card does not work?**

If the mobile card does not work, even though the card distributor has activated it for you, check that you are logging in with the same email address with which the card issuer created your account.

#### **The cardboard card still works**

The cardboard Kaikukortti still works, and it is not mandatory to use the mobile Kaikukortti.





## OmaKaiku

Even if you do not want to use the mobile Kaikukortti, you can ask the person who issued your Kaikukortti to activate the OmaKaiku service for you. You must have a personal email address to be able to use it.

From the OmaKaiku service, you can, for example:

- see how you have used your own Kaikukortti
- send feedback on cultural and sports venues events (if they have published them on OmaKaiku)
- see what events you can participate in with a Kaikukortti. Unfortunately, not all events will appear on the mobile Kaikukortti or on OmaKaiku. Kaikukortti venues decide for themselves whether to publish their program on OmaKaiku or not.

Mobile-Kaikukortti users automatically have OmaKaiku enabled.

## Privacy policy

Your name will appear only on your personal Kaikukortti card. Your name, date of birth, personal ID number, address or phone number will not be entered in the Kaikukortti register. When you receive your Kaikukortti you will be asked certain personal background details, such as your native language. Submission of these details is **largely voluntary, but your year of birth, postal code, and number of children/grandchildren are mandatory.**

The actors in the Kaikukortti network will not register your name, address or phone number when you obtain a ticket with Kaikukortti. **The adult education centres are an exception**, they require personal details for enrolment on their courses.

**OmaKaiku: Your identification details** (first name, last name, email address, phone number, location, and user interface language) **are only stored in OmaKaiku. No information that could be used to identify you is stored in the Kaikukortti register Kaikukanta.** No Kaikukanta user has access to the information stored in OmaKaiku.

### **Where is Kaikukortti valid?**

You can use Kaikukortti to get a ticket for the cultural venues that are part of the Kaikukortti network, such as festivals, summer theatres, sport venues and museums. Kaikukortti applies to most of the cultural services offered by these venues. You can also use Kaikukortti to participate in adult education courses. The Kaikukortti venues are listed in this brochure.

The Kaikukortti venues in the Kaikukortti network state on their own websites which events, shows or courses Kaikukortti can be used for. You can also telephone them and ask them which of their services are covered by Kaikukortti.

**You can also use your card in the other Kaikukortti localities.** Further information and links to the Kaikukortti pages at the websites of other participating localities: [www.kaikukortti.fi/en/localities](http://www.kaikukortti.fi/en/localities).

**Kaikukortti pop up:** Tickets to the three museums of the Finnish National Gallery in Helsinki (Ateneum Art Museum, Museum of Contemporary Art Kiasma and Sinebrychoff Art Museum) are also available with Kaikukortti. In 2026, Kaikukortti will also be valid in Helsinki at the Amos Rex Museum, the Tahto Sports Museum, the Museum of Photography and the Natural History Museum (Luomus).



### **Kaikukortti practices vary at Kaikukortti venues**

Kaikukortti venues offer their services to Kaikukortti holders in good faith and based on their values, and they do not receive separate compensation for tickets purchased with Kaikukortti.

**Practices regarding Kaikukortti may vary at Kaikukortti locations.** It is important to check in advance on the venues' websites or brochures which events are included in the Kaikukortti offering.

**Tickets purchased with Kaikukortti may not be left unused without a compelling reason.** If you leave a ticket unused, you may be taking away some else's place and also potential ticket revenue from the Kaikukortti venue.



## How to use Kaikukortti to get an entrance ticket or course place?

With Kaikukortti you can get a ticket through the Kaikukortti venue's own ticket sales channel. Be prepared to show your Kaikukortti and its code (number and/or letter combination) when getting the ticket. You cannot necessarily use Kaikukortti to get tickets from an online shop. **The number of available Kaikukortti tickets may be limited.**

If you get a ticket through Lippupiste or another commercial ticket broker, you have to pay a service charge even though the ticket itself is free of charge.

It is possible to get tickets directly from most of the Kaikukortti venues without having to pay a service charge.

If you want to take a course at an adult education centre, enrol for the course as usual in advance and then contact the office of the given centre to give them your Kaikukortti code.

**There may be a limited number of Kaikukortti course places available.**

## Bring your Kaikukortti with you

Bring your Kaikukortti with you when attending an event or course. The staff may request to see it. **They may also ask you to prove your identity.**

## Tickets for children


If you have children or grandchildren under the age of 18, you can also use your Kaikukortti to get tickets for them when you attend the event together.


Children or grandchildren may not however attend the adult education courses with you.

## Kaikukortti for communities

If you are interested in going to an event with a small group or an employee, you should ask if an employee of a community distributing Kaikukortti would like to attend the event with you.

The social welfare, healthcare and wellbeing actors that distribute Kaikukortti also have Kaikukortti cards for communities. Employees, volunteers and other representatives of communities can use Kaikukortti for communities to get a





free entrance ticket **for themselves and their clients who are under 16 years old** when organizing a small group visit for one or more clients. Clients aged 16 or older must bring along their own Kaikukortti cards when attending the event. A small group can consist of, for example, 2-5 persons. Kaikukortti for communities can't be used for the adult education courses.

### **Free entrance for assistants**

**Assistants to persons using the Kaikukortti card are always entitled to free admission.** The assistant may be, for example, an assistant of a person with physical disabilities, a guide of a visually impaired person or an instructor of a person with developmental disabilities. An interpreter may be a Sign Language interpreter, a speech-to-text interpreter or a communication assistant. The holder of the Kaikukortti card needs to get a separate ticket for the assistant or interpreter.

### **Kaikukortti nationwide**

The aim of Kaikukortti is to improve the opportunities of young people, adults and families who are financially hard-pressed to participate in cultural life and engage in arts and culture.

Kaikukortti is used at several Finnish localities. You can use your Kaikukortti for cultural events organised at any Kaikukortti locality.
